Feb. 21 - Safety meeting with Zone 6

Absentee owners/abandoned houses - code enforcement issues, owners can be forced to secure empty houses if code enforcement "placquered" them. If a house is placquered it means Zone 6 can arrest people there (trespassing warrants). Owner has to verbally tell the trespasser "you are trespassing" - police can't do it for the owner. Placquering basically means that the city can say, "no trespassing" on behalf of the owner.
